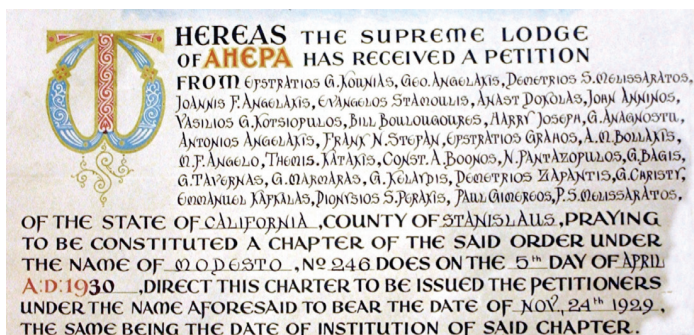

One of their first projects was to collect donations for the building to eventually be the Annunciation Church of Modesto which was consecrated on September 14, 1930 by Bishop Kallistos, assisted by Father Caravellas and Father George Sardounis from Sacramento. Apostolos Maheras, Consul General of Greece was also present as well as 2,500 Orthodox Christians from around the state. AHEPA Chapter 246 was one of the major donors. 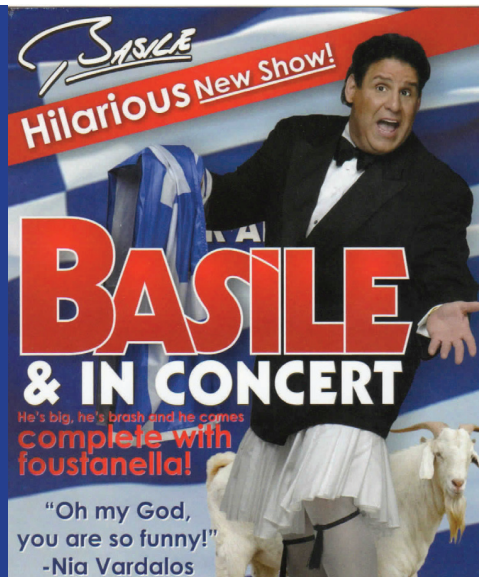
